

Performance during February, 2013

- (i) Commission advised issuance of sanction for prosecution in respect of **12** officials of various Ministries/Departments/ Organizations during the month which include an IFS officer (the then Chief Executive Officer Integrated Watershed Development Programme (IWDP), M/o Environment & Forests, a Commander Works Engineer from M/o Defence and a Superintending Engineer in Lakshadweep Administration.
- (ii) Prosecution sanctions were issued by the Competent Authorities in respect of **19** officials of various Ministries/Departments/ Organizations during the month which include an IFS officer (the then Chief Executive Officer) Integrated Watershed Development Programme (IWDP), M/o Environment & Forests and a General Manager of Oriental Insurance Co. Ltd.
- (iii) Commission processed **4677** complaints (including **70** whistle blower complaints) during the month and sought investigation/factual report in **88** complaints from the concerned Ministries/Departments/Organizations.
- (iv) Commission advised initiation of major penalty proceedings against **122** officials of various Ministries/Departments/Organizations which include four General Managers of Industrial Development Bank of India, a Commissioner of Central Board of Excise & Customs, a Joint Secretary (Retd.) from Planning Commission, two General Managers (Mining) of Central Coalfields Ltd., a Superintending Engineer of Delhi Development Authority, a Superintending Engineer of Lakshadweep Administration, two General Managers of Pawan Hans Helicopters Ltd. and a Joint Director of National Institute of Fashion Technology,
- (v) Commission advised imposition of major penalty against **35** officials of various Ministries/Departments/Organizations, which include a Principal Scientist of Indian Council of Agricultural Research, a General Manager from Central Coalfields Ltd., a Director from Delhi Development Authority and a Superintending Engineer (Retd.) of Delhi Development Authority.
- (vi) On the advice of the Commission, the Competent Authorities imposed major penalties in respect of **184** officials of various Ministries/Departments/Organizations, which include a Scientist (Grade-E) of Bureau of Indian Standards, a General Manager from Syndicate Bank, a General Manager of Central Bank of India, a Dy. Commissioner (Retd.) of Central Board of Excise & Customs, a Joint Financial Advisor(Housing) from Delhi Development Authority, a the then Member (A&E) and a Director of Deptt. of Defence Production and Supplies, and two Superintending Engineers from Eastern Coalfields Ltd.
- (vii) Chief Technical Examiner's Organization submitted **one** technical examination report and the examinations resulted in recovery of Rs. **6,48,87,338/-** during February, 2013.
- (viii) Commission processed **36** matters for vigilance clearance of officials for Board level appointments in CPSE's. In addition, references of **137** All India Services and Central Services officers were considered for vigilance clearance in matters of empanelment etc.
- (ix) **57** officers were considered for appointment/empanelment as full time CVOs in various organizations.

B. Important activities:

- (i) Shri R. Sri Kumar, Vigilance Commissioner inaugurated a one day work shop on E-tendering and Reverse/forward Auction organized by Airports Authority of India (AAI) at India Aviation Academy, New Delhi on 28th Feb, 2013. The objective of the workshop was to create awareness among the officials of AAI on Reverse & forward auctioning in procurement process of AAI. The workshop was attended by more than 60 executives of the rank from AGM to ED level from Engineering, CNS, Commercial, Finance, Technical and Equipment Directorates. While addressing the participants, Shri R. Sri Kumar stressed the need for changing to “Open Competitive Mode” to become fair game player and provide more transparent environment to the vendors/service providers. He emphasized the need to leverage technology to invite more competition and transparency. On the conclusion of workshop a panel discussion was held in which Shri Anil Singhal, Chief Technical Examiner, CVC presided over the proceedings.

- (ii) Shri J.M. Garg, Vigilance Commissioner addressed a meeting of the Chief Executives (CEOs) of the Public Sector Banks convened by Department of Financial Services(DFS), Ministry of Finance on 5th Feb, 2013 at New Delhi. In the interaction with the CEO's of Banks and officers of DFS he highlighted specific issues related to vigilance administration in Banking Sector.
