

## Performance during January, 2014

- (i) Commission advised issuance of sanction for prosecution in respect of **3** officials of various Ministries/Departments/Organizations during the month which include a Chief Signal and Telecom Engineer from Ministry of Railways.
- (ii) Prosecution sanctions were issued by the Competent Authorities in respect of **10** officials of various Ministries/Departments/ Organizations during the month which include an IAS officer of Andhra Pradesh and two IAS officers of Madhya Pradesh.
- (iii) Commission processed **2511** complaints (including **29** whistle blower complaints) during the month and sought investigation/factual report in **79** complaints from the concerned Ministries/Departments/Organizations.
- (iv) Commission advised initiation of major penalty proceedings against **69** officials of various Ministries/Departments/Organizations which include Chairman, Airport Authority of India, General Manager from Bank of India, two General Managers from Industrial Development Bank of India, an Executive Director from Ministry of Railways, two Commissioners of Income Tax and Chairman and Managing Director of Air India.
- (v) Commission advised imposition of major penalty against **11** officials of various Ministries/Departments/Organizations, which include a General Manager from Syndicate Bank.
- (vi) On the advice of the Commission, the Competent Authorities imposed major penalties in respect of **66** officials of various Ministries/Departments/Organizations, which include a Commissioner of Income Tax.
- (vii) Intensive Examination of **3** works carried out by Chief Technical Examiner's Organization resulted in recoveries to the tune of **Rs. 135,24,844/-** during January, 2014.
- (viii) Commission provided inputs in respect of **18** cases for vigilance clearance of officials for Board level appointments in CPSE's. In addition, references of **64** officials of All India Services and Central Services were considered for vigilance clearance in matters of empanelment, promotion etc. and inputs provided by the Commission.
- (ix) **23** officers were considered for appointment/empanelment as full time/part time CVOs in various organizations and recommendations were given by the Commission.

**B. Important activities:**

- (i) Shri Pradeep Kumar, Central Vigilance Commissioner was the Chief Guest at the third anniversary celebrations of Vigilance Study Circle, Mumbai on 8<sup>th</sup> January, 2014. While addressing the participants CVC laid emphasis on the need to inculcate ethics and moral values amongst the school going children so that they grow up to become responsible and upright citizens of the country.
