

Performance during December, 2013

- (i) Commission advised issuance of sanction for prosecution in respect of **6** officials of various Ministries/Departments/Organizations during the month which include an IFS officer of Andhra Pradesh Cadre.
- (ii) Prosecution sanctions were issued by the Competent Authorities in respect of **23** officials of various Ministries/Departments/ Organizations during the month which include a General Manager from Industrial Development Bank of India and two Executive Engineers from Ministry of Urban Development.
- (iii) Commission processed **1251** complaints (including **22** whistle blower complaints) during the month and sought investigation/factual report in **54** complaints from the concerned Ministries/Departments/Organizations.
- (iv) Commission advised initiation of major penalty proceedings against **71** officials of various Ministries/Departments/Organizations which include a Joint Director of the Indian Council of Agricultural Research, four General Managers from Industrial Development Bank of India, an Executive Director of Dena Bank, an IFS officer of Andhra Pradesh Cadre, the then Chairman and Managing Director of National Project Construction Corporation Ltd. and a General Manager from Bharat Heavy Electricals Ltd.
- (v) Commission advised imposition of major penalty against **39** officials of various Ministries/Departments/Organizations, which include three Superintending Engineers from Delhi Development Authority and a General Manager from UCO Bank.
- (vi) On the advice of the Commission, the Competent Authorities imposed major penalties in respect of **92** officials of various Ministries/Departments/Organizations, which include a General Manager from Air India, a General Manager from Punjab National Bank, a Chief Engineer and Superintending Engineer from Delhi Development Authority.
- (vii) Intensive Examination of **1** work carried out by Chief Technical Examiner's Organization resulted in recoveries to the tune of **Rs. 38,93,000/-** during December, 2013.
- (viii) Commission provided inputs in respect of **33** cases for vigilance clearance of officials for Board level appointments in CPSE's. In addition, references of **275** officials of All India Services and Central Services were considered for vigilance clearance in matters of empanelment, promotion etc. and inputs provided by the Commission.
- (ix) **14** officers were considered for appointment/empanelment as full time/part time CVOs in various organizations and recommendations were given by the Commission.

B. Important activities:

- (i) Shri Pradeep Kumar, Central Vigilance Commissioner addressed the participants during the International Conference on Integrity Pact organized by the Transparency International India in collaboration with the Global Compact Network, India at New Delhi on International Anti-Corruption Day i.e., 09.12.2013.

- (ii) Shri R. Sri Kumar, Vigilance Commissioner attended National Conference on Cyber Space Security (NCCSS) 2013 on December 6-7, 2013 at Banagalore. The conference was attended by personnel from corporate sector, legal experts, policy makers and academia.
